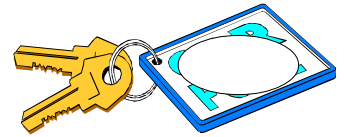

SHHS Graduation Ceremony - Wednesday, June 25, 2008

Plans for the graduation ceremony are well
under way. The ceremony will be held on
Wednesday, June 25 at 7:00 p.m., in the
Sacred Heart High School gymnasium.
Students must confirm their intention to
attend graduation by submitting their grad
fee of \$40.00. This fee is due at the
guidance office by May 30.



Students who wish to be included in the
newspaper publications of the SHHS Graduating Class 2008
should submit this information and the \$10.00 fee at the
guidance office by Friday, May 30.

Graduates must ensure that their documentation of 40 hours
community service has been submitted at the main office by
Tuesday, June 17 (the first day of exams). This documentation
is a requirement for any student to receive an Ontario Secondary
School Diploma. Other requirements include a minimum of 30
credits of which 18 are compulsory and the successful
completion of the literacy requirement. Students who do not
meet these requirements will not be eligible to receive their
diploma.

On the evening of the graduation ceremony, the graduates are
required to meet in the drama classroom at 6:15 p.m. The
graduation ceremony will begin at 7:00 p.m. and will last
approximately two hours. Graduates, family and friends are
invited to enjoy refreshments in the school cafeteria following
the ceremony.

Roots of Bruce - Volunteers Needed April 3 & 4, 2008

High school students are
needed to assist at the Roots of
Bruce on Thursday, April 3 and
Friday, April 4, 2008. The Roots
of Bruce held at the Walkerton
Agricultural Buildings, provides
an interactive learning program
for grade 5 and 6 students from
Bruce County. The high school
students will aid the local commodity food groups and

elementary students. No farm experience is needed and
training will be provided.

school sponsored absence and must inform their teachers
of their planned absence ahead of time. Students are
responsible for the work they will miss during this class
time.

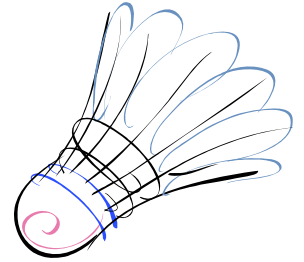
